ONWARDS AND UPWARDS July 2022

It was with pleasure and surprise that I discovered afresh this Pentecost the traditional hymn to the Holy Spirit we sang at school, 'Come Holy Ghost Creator Come'. As we began to sing it I was struck by the lines in verse one "Come take possession of our souls, and make them all thine own." Having sung these simple lines so often as a boy with only slight understanding, I suddenly realised that this had become one of the most important prayers and endeavours of my life.

I have been thinking recently what the phrase, "Living in the Spirit" means. The first thing that comes to mind is recognising the Spirit living in me and directing my life. This is connected to an idea I have heard a lot recently through ecumenical circles, "knowing who I am in Christ".

If I know my identity in Christ, I will know how much he wants to give me his Spirit afresh on a daily basis to love and to live out my vocation. Part of what stops me accepting my identity in Christ and truly valuing his life in me is my upbringing, my own past mistakes, and how these affected my self-esteem.

If you, like me, want to journey deeper in your identity in Christ and know his peace and the other fruits of the Spirit in your life, you may be interested in the healing courses currently available at Clare Priory.

And we are delighted that our next Day of Renewal is in the beautiful church and grounds of Clare Priory in Suffolk. We will have two speakers, with Fr Gladson and Fr Stefan opening up the scriptures for us and inspiring us to meet the Lord afresh through Jesus' words in Matt 9:28 our theme for the day. There will be a healing service as part of the day.
